



## CONSULTATION MEETINGS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ON FINANCIAL LITERACY

The Foundation has worked closely with Australian Government, State and Territory officials to develop the National Consumer and Financial Literacy Framework, which establishes the nationally agreed multi-disciplinary benchmarks and guidance for teaching financial literacy in the compulsory years of schooling.

The National Framework for schools identified professional development as a critical issue. The Foundation is developing a national approach to professional development to facilitate delivery of the objectives of the Framework.

In order to take this forward, the Financial Literacy Foundation is planning to conduct meetings with teachers across the States and Territories on the following dates to identify their professional development needs.
